PRIVACY POLICY

1. INFORMATION TO THE USER

PURE CHEMICALS IBÉRICA, SL, hereinafter RESPONSIBLE, is responsible for the treatment of the personal data of the User and informs him that this data will be treated in accordance with the provisions of the regulations in force in protection of personal data, the Regulation (EU) 2016 / 679 of April 27, 2016 (GDPR) relating to the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and the free circulation of these data, for which the following treatment information is provided: End of the treatment: maintain a commercial relationship with the User. The operations planned to carry out the treatment are:

-Submission of commercial advertising communications by email, fax, SMS, MMS, social communities or any other electronic or physical means, present or future, that enables commercial communications, provided they have been previously authorized. These communications will be made by the RESPONSIBLE and related to your products and services, or to your collaborators or suppliers with whom this has reached a promotion agreement. In this case, third parties will never have access to personal data. -Conduct statistical studies. -Process orders, requests or any type of request that is made by the user through any of the contact forms that are made available to them.

-Forward the newsletter on the website. Data conservation criteria: they will be kept while there is a mutual interest to maintain the end of the treatment and when it is no longer necessary for this purpose, they will be eliminated with adequate security measures to guarantee the pseudonymisation of the data or the total destruction of the data. same. Communication of the data: The data will not be communicated to third parties, except legal obligation.

-Rights that assist the User:

-Right to withdraw consent at any time.

-Right of access, rectification, portability and deletion of your data and the limitation or opposition to your treatment.

-Right to file a claim with the control authority (www.aepd.es.)

-if you consider that the treatment does not comply with current regulations.

2. COMPULSORY OR OPTIONAL CHARACTER OF THE INFORMATION PROVIDED BY THE USER Users, by marking the corresponding boxes and entering data in the fields, marked with an asterisk (*) in the contact form or presented in download forms, expressly and freely and unequivocally accept that their data are necessary to meet your request, by the provider, being voluntary the inclusion of data in the remaining fields. The User guarantees that the personal data provided to the RESPONSIBLE person is true and is responsible for communicating any modification thereof.

The RESPONSIBLE informs and expressly guarantees users that their personal data will not be transferred in any case to third parties, and that whenever they make any kind of transfer of personal data, the express, informed and unequivocal consent of the Users will be requested in advance. All data requested through the website are mandatory, as they are necessary for the provision of an optimal service to the User. In case all the data are not provided, it is not guaranteed that the information and services provided will be completely adjusted to your needs.

3. SECURITY MEASURES That in accordance with the provisions in the regulations in force on personal data protection, the RESPONSIBLE is complying with all the provisions of the GDPR regulations for the treatment of personal data of its responsibility, and manifestly with the principles described in article 5 of the GDPR, for which they are treated in a lawful, loyal and transparent manner in relation to the interested party and adequate, pertinent and limited to what is necessary in relation to the purposes for which they are treated.

The RESPONSIBLE guarantees that he has implemented appropriate technical and organizational policies to apply the security measures established by the GDPR in order to protect the rights and freedoms of the Users and has communicated the appropriate information so that they can exercise them.

INFORMATION ON COOKIES

Due to the entry into force of the reference modification of the "Law of Services of the Information Society" (LSSICE) established by Royal Decree 13/2012, it is mandatory to obtain the express consent of the user of all web pages that they use dispensable cookies, before it navigates through them.

WHAT ARE COOKIES?

Cookies and other similar technologies such as local shared objects, flash cookies or pixels, are tools used by Web servers to store and retrieve information about their visitors, as well as to offer a correct functioning of the site.

By using these devices the Web server is allowed to remember some information concerning the user, such as their preferences for viewing the pages of that server, name and password, products that interest them most, etc.

COOKIES AFFECTED BY THE LEGISLATION AND EXCEPTED COOKIES

According to the EU directive, cookies that require informed consent by the user are analytical cookies and advertising and affiliation cookies, except those of a technical nature and those necessary for the operation of the website or the provision of services. expressly requested by the user.

WHAT TYPES OF COOKIES EXIST?

About the types of cookies, there are five major groups:

Analytical cookies: collect information on the use made of the website.

Social cookies: are those necessary for external social networks.

Affiliate cookies: allow you to track visits from other websites, with which the website establishes an affiliation contract (affiliation companies).

Advertising and behavioral cookies: they collect information about the preferences and personal choices of the user (retargeting).

Technical and functional cookies: they are strictly necessary for the use of the website and for the provision of the contracted service.

COOKIES THAT ARE USED ON THIS WEBSITE

PHPSESSID: technical and strictly necessary cookie that contains the identifier of the session. It is deleted when the browser is closed.

_lang: technical and strictly necessary cookie that contains the language of the session. It is deleted when the browser is closed.

ac_cookies: technical and strictly necessary cookie that contains the value of whether the installation of

cookies has been accepted. Expires in 1 year since the last update.

_ga: Google Analytics cookie that enables the control of unique visits. The first time a user enters the website through a browser this cookie will be installed. When this user re-enters the web with the same browser, the cookie will consider that it is the same user. Only in the case that the user changes the browser, another user will be considered. Expires at 2 years since the last update.

_utma: Google Analytics cookie that records the date of the first and last time the user visited the site Web. Expires at 2 years since the last update.

_utmb: Google Analytics cookie that records the time of arrival at the website. Expires 30 minutes after the last update.

_utmz: Google Analytics cookie used for interoperability with the urchin.js tracking code. It is deleted when the browser is closed.

_utmt: Google Analytics cookie. This cookie is used to process the type of request requested by the user. Expires at the end of the session.

_utmjv: Google Analytics cookie. This cookie is used to segment demographic data. Expires at the end of the session.

REVOCACTION OF CONSENT TO INSTALL COOKIES HOW TO REMOVE THE BROWSER'S COOKIES

Chrome

1. Select the Tools icon
2. Click on Settings.
3. Click on Show Advanced Options.
4. In the "Privacy" section, click on Content settings.
 - Delete cookies: Click on All cookies and site data ...
 - Do not allow cookies to be stored.
5. Click on Delete browsing data (empty the Cache).
6. Close and restart the browser.
